The charity raises funds by means of a payroll lottery and other appropriate activities for distribution to charitable and community groups for the public benefit in the local Government area of Fife, the United Kingdom and elsewhere.

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the financial period During the year the charity received lottery contributions of £74,196.50 with winnings paid out of £39,500. 50 grants were made during the year of between £180 and £1,800 to various causes, totalling £36,718.79 for the year. £500.00 was awarded in 2018/19 but the cheque was not cashed until 2019/20. No bank interest was received in the year.

### Financial review

The charity's result for the year was a deficit of £5,811.74 with expenditure exceeding income. Surplus built up over the years means funds were available. The unrestricted funds represent income received but not yet utilized.




